President of Guatemala visits Novaguatemala, Nueva Pescanova Group's subsidiary in the country

In turn, Mike Corser, general director of Novaguatemala, considered the visit "a great milestone for the company, since it has allowed us to promote the work we do, the role of the sector as an engine of growth and employment in the country and the strong social commitment we have in the Champerico region".
